

# Planning Guide

## CREST Community Plan

### IN YOUR HOME:

- Stay calm and keep your family together
- Call 911 to alert authorities
- Conserve and maintain a water supply
- Keep doors and windows closed but unlocked
- Stay inside your house, away from exterior walls and windows

### IN YOUR CAR:

- Stay calm and park away from vegetation
- Call 911 to alert authorities
- Close all windows and vents
- Cover your mouth and nose with a dry cloth
- Cover your body with a wool blanket or jacket
- Lie on the floor of the vehicle until the fire passes

### ON FOOT:

- Stay calm and find an area clear from vegetation, a ditch or depression on level ground
- Call 911 to alert authorities
- Lie face down and cover up your body
- Cover your mouth with a dry cloth to protect your airway

**GET READY, GET SET, GO!**  
Wildfire Is Coming. Are You Ready?

GET PREPARED FOR WILDFIRE BEFORE IT STRIKES BY FOLLOWING THE READY, SET GO! GUIDE:

**BEING READY**

100 FT → UP TO 1 MILE

CREATE DEFENSIBLE SPACE: 100-FEET OF DEFENSIBLE SPACE IS REQUIRED AROUND YOUR HOME. LEARN HOW TO MAINTAIN THE TWO ZONES OF DEFENSIBLE SPACE NEEDED.

HARDEN YOUR HOME: FLYING EMBERS CAN DESTROY HOMES UP TO A MILE FROM WILDLAND AREAS. LEARN HOW TO PROTECT AND HARDEN YOUR HOME FROM A WILDFIRE THREAT.

**BEING READY TO GO**

PRE-EVACUATION STEPS: PREPARE BOTH THE INSIDE AND OUTSIDE OF YOUR HOUSE FOR EVACUATION. GET THE CHECKLISTS.

REVIEW YOUR EVACUATION PLAN CHECKLIST.

**GO!**

EVACUATION STEPS: WHEN IMMEDIATE EVACUATION IS NECESSARY, GET READY TO GO!

ENSURE YOUR EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT IS IN YOUR VEHICLE.

COVER-UP TO PROTECT AGAINST HEAT AND FLYING EMBERS. WEAR LONG PANTS, LONG SLEEVE SHIRT, HEAVY SHOES/BOOTS, CAP DRY BANDANNA TO COVER FACE, GOGGLES OR GLASSES. 100% COTTON IS PREFERABLE.

LOCATE YOUR PETS AND TAKE THEM WITH YOU.

The best route to be utilized will be determined by the Sheriff's Department and Fire Officials with the safety of the public as a first priority. The Term P.A.C.E. will be utilized to determine the best route for the public evacuation.

## **P: Primary** - Main Roads and Highways

- La Cresta Rd

## **A: Alternate** - Secondary Roads outside of normal traffic Flow

- Mountain View Rd

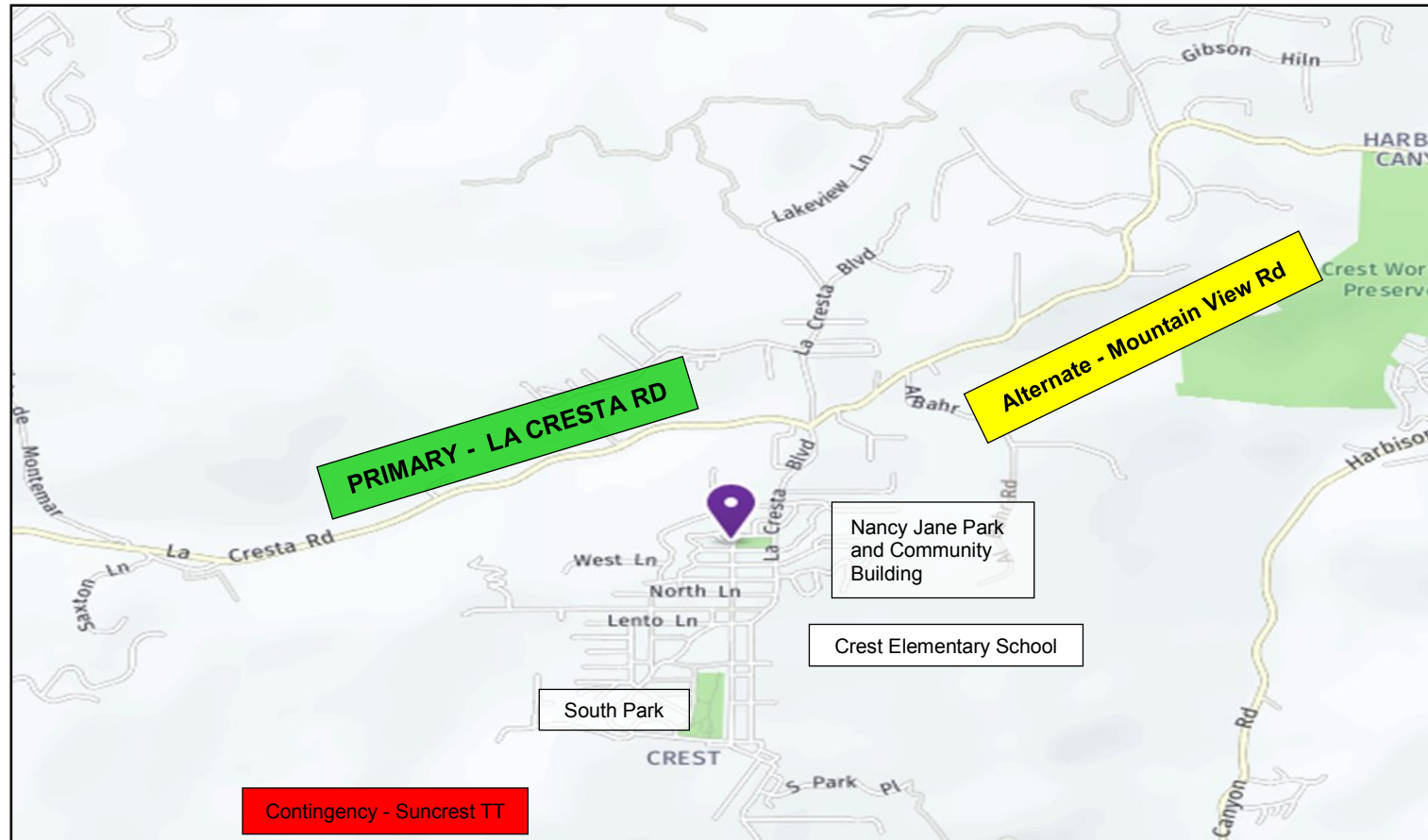
## **C: Contingency** - Truck Trails or other routes if Primary and Alternate routes are compromised

- Suncrest Truck Trail

## **E: Emergency** - Temporary Refuge Area (TRA) or Shelter in Place

- Crest Elementary School Grounds
- Nancy Jane Park
- Home or Community Building
- South Lane Park

## My Evacuation Routes (Highlight the **Primary** and **Alternate** routes from your home)

**Primary** - La Cresta Rd

**Alternate** - Mountain View Rd

**Contingency** - Suncrest Truck Trail

**Emergency** - SHELTER IN PLACE ONLY IF SURVIVABLE AND WITH TRAs IN EVACUATION PLANNING

Drive With Caution

- Make sure your headlights are on
- When conditions are smoky, proceed slowly and stop if you can't see
- Watch for emergency vehicles and yield the right of way
- Roll up your windows, ensure your radio is off and turn on your air conditioner to Max Cold
